ADVISEMENT OF CONFIDENTIALITY REGULATIONS Internship Program

I have read, reviewed and understand, that as a U.S. Pretrial Services Intern or Volunteer, I am bound to comply with the requirements of Title 18 United States Code 3153 (c)(1), in that:

"Information obtained in the course of performing Pretrial Services functions in relation to a particular accused shall be used only for the purposes of bail determination and shall otherwise be confidential".

These regulations require that as a U.S. Pretrial Services Intern or Volunteer, I cannot talk to any person(s) from the media, employers, family, or friends of the accused, regarding any aspect of the case, without first having obtained the permission my Supervisor or the Deputy Chief U.S. Pretrial Services Officer, or Chief U.S. Pretrial Services Officer.

In the event I am approached by a law enforcement officer, I cannot disclose any confidential information regarding the accused unless there is an outstanding warrant for the accused or, there is reason to believe the accused has committed a new crime, without first obtaining the permission of my Supervisor or the Deputy Chief U.S. Pretrial Services Officer, or Chief U.S. Pretrial Services Officer.
