

Qualifications for Appointment

To be eligible to participate in the United States Pretrial Services Internship / Volunteer program, the following prerequisites must be met:



- Must be a United States citizen or eligible to work for the U.S. Government.
- Junior, Senior, or Graduate student in good class standing at an accredited educational institution, or be a recent graduate.
- Minimum academic grade point average of 3.0 on a 4-point scale within the major.
- Enrolled in at least half time in a course of study related to the work to be performed.
- Able to commit to a minimum of 12 hours per week. Work hours will be established in accordance with office needs and individual school requirements.
- Able to commit to a length of service for a minimum of three consecutive months.
- Physical, mental, and emotional health must be such that student is capable of carrying out the activities required by the internship.
- Must not use any illegal controlled substance.
- Free of any prior criminal history.
